Short-stay visa

This type of visa is generally issued for tourism, business trips or family visits.to France. which includes activities such as attending conferences, meetings, training, academic research or attending an event.

A 25% administrative fee will be deducted from ticket prices to cover invitation letter processing and issuance, and related costs before processing refunds if the visa is rejected.

Attendees are advised to apply for a social visit visa only. Check <https://france-visas.gouv.fr> for visa guidelines .

EIU Paris does not support applications for student or business visas.

All attendees are required to return to their home countries following the conclusion of the convocation ceremony.

Introduction

If you are not a UK national, it is likely that you will need to apply for a Visit Visa before you leave your home country.

Business or Academic visits

You can apply for a Standard Visitor visa to the UK which includes activities such as attending conferences, meetings, training, academic research or a sabbatical.

Visit the UK as a Standard Visitor

You can visit the UK as a Standard Visitor for tourism, business, study (courses up to 6 months) and other permitted activities.

You can usually stay in the UK for up to 6 months

A Standard Visitor visa costs £100 for up to 6 months. The earliest you can apply is 3 months before you travel.

Visa Guidelines

What Are the Required Documents for a UK Visa?

You should submit the following documents to apply for a UK visa:

- UK visa application form. You may have to complete the form online on <https://www.gov.uk/standard-visitor/apply-standard-visitor-visa> 
- Two photographs. These photos should be taken within the past six months and in color.
- Your Valid Passport. It must be valid for three more months beyond the date you plan to leave the UK after your trip. It must also have at least one blank page for the visa.
- Proof you have the financial means to cover the living costs while in the UK. This may be your bank statements for the last six months, or pay slips for the same period.
- Proof of accommodation. You will need to present a document that shows where you will be accommodated while in the UK. Note that you do not have to fully pay a hotel/hostel in UK before getting the visa, just to get such a document.
- Detailed travel itinerary. Submit a travel plan that gives all the information regarding how and what you are planning to do in the UK. Include the travel dates, places you will visit, meeting agenda, booked tour, festival agenda, etc. Click here to learn how to book dummy flight tickets for UK visa.
- Tuberculosis Test Results. Only nationals of some countries will need to submit the requests of a Tuberculosis Test in order to be eligible for a UK Visa. Check here if you need to provide the TB test results.
- Paid UK visa fees. You should submit the receipt that confirms you have paid the visa fee as required.
